The principal mission of the Rutland Township Board of Trustees and management is the delivery of goods and services to Rutland Township residents on a cost-efficient basis.

Modest property tax levies were adopted by the Board. Those levies were based upon demonstrated need, not upon the higher maximum levels allowable under State and County guidelines.

Cash reserves are maintained at a level that management believes is sufficient, but not excessive, to meet current and future capital and operating needs, and to provide for unanticipated or emergency events.

The Township Board and management are pleased to report that the financial condition of Rutland Township and Rutland Township Road District remains strong. The Township has no debt and no plans to incur any debt in the foreseeable future. It is expected that any capital outlay will be financed from current operating cash flows.
